

**CITY OF SOUTHGATE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
July 5, 2017
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

Call to Order: Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

The following answered roll call: Council Members Anderson, Hayley, Speier, Payne, and Robisch were present. Council Member Enzweiler was absent. Also present: Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, City Clerk Barton, Police Chief Christmann, Fire Chief Beatsch, and City Attorney Stewart. Public Works Foreman Bowman was absent.

Public Comments: Council Member Payne presented the Park & Tree Board Green Thumb Awards to 153 North (Minning) and 2404 Joyce (Hill, Kloos, and Breithoupt).

Public Works: Councilman Anderson had no report.

Public Safety: Councilman Speier said if anyone sees a trouble spot in the City for speeding or moving violations to please report them to the Police. Police Chief Christmann distributed the May stats report. Council Member Robisch asked if any action can be taken for unpaid parking citations in the City. After discussion, Police Chief said that he would report to Mayor and Council on the number of unpaid citations for the year. Fire Chief Beatsch said the Fire Department is preparing for the Block Party on July 15th.

Motion/Second: Robisch/Anderson. Approved by voice vote: Aye 5 Nay 0.**


Old Business: Council Member Payne thanked Police Officer who removed a raccoon from trash can.
