**Call to Order:** Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**The following answered roll call:** Council Members Enzweiler, Hayley, Anderson, Payne, Robisch, and Speier were present. Also present: Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, City Clerk Barton, Police Chief Christmann, Public Works Foreman Bowman, and Bryce Rhoades in for City Attorney Mary Ann Stewart. 
