

**CITY OF SOUTHGATE  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
April 4, 2018  
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

**Call to Order:** Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**The following answered roll call:** Council Members Hayley, Speier, Enzweiler, and Robisch were present. Council Member Payne arrived late. Councilman Anderson was absent. Also present: Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, City Clerk Barton, Police Chief Christmann, Public Works Foreman Bowman, Fire Chief Beatsch, and City Attorney Stewart.

**Public Comments:** none.

**Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes of 03/21/18. Motion/Second: Robisch/Hayley. Approved by voice vote: Aye 4 Nay 0.**

**Public Works:** Public Works Foreman Bowman said that construction on Center Street has begun. Concrete work on the curbs will be done next week if the weather improves. Mr. Bowman gave an estimate of \$3,000 to do the work around the dam by the lake. Mayor Hamberg said this was budgeted and to go forward with the work.

**Public Safety:** Councilman Speier said there will be a SWEMS meeting on 4/10 in Southgate. Police Chief Christmann reported that one of the new cruisers have been delivered. The other vehicle is being outfitted for the K-9. He will determine which of the old cruisers will be surplus after evaluation of the vehicles. There will be a demo of the new radios on 4/10 in Alexandria. Fire Chief Beatsch said that the Spaghetti Dinner Night at the Races on 3/24 went well. There is a Fire Department sponsored Comedy Night on 4/14. Fire Chief Beatsch discussed the cost of the new radios and a possible grant that the dept. could get to help with the cost of the radios.

**Code Enforcement:** Councilman Enzweiler said there were 16 active cases.

**Community Relations & Recreation:** Council Member Payne reported on upcoming events: Arbor Day Activities on 4/20 and Campbell Co. Clean Up on 4/13-14.

**Public Buildings:** Council Member Robisch had no report.

**Finance and Administration:** Council Member Hayley reviewed the payables. **There was a motion made to approve the Feb. Financials. Motion/Second: Hayley/Enzweiler. Approved by voice vote: Aye 5 Nay 0.**

Finance Director Hudson had no report. City Clerk Barton said that the health insurance rate renewal came in favorable. City Attorney Stewart had no report, but read the following:

**Old Business:** Council Member Speier asked about the outdoor seating text amendment to the zoning ordinance. City Clerk Barton said that she sent the information discussed at the last meeting to Campbell Co. Planning & Zoning. The CCPZ Commission meets in May. After the May meeting the proposed text amendments will be brought to the Council for review.

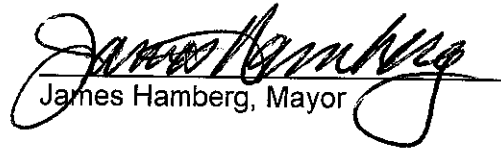
**New Business:** none.
