COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
April 18, 2018
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

Call to Order: Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

The following answered roll call: Council Members Hayley, Speier, Anderson, and Payne were present. Council Members Enzweiler, and Robisch were absent. Also present: City Clerk Barton, Public Works Foreman Bowman, Police Sergeant Johns, and Assistant City Attorney Rhoades. Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson and Fire Chief Beatsch were absent.

Public Comments: Connie Grubbs who is running for County Commissioner for District 1 introduced herself to Council.

Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes of 4/4/18. Motion/Second: Hayley/Speier. Approved by voice vote: Aye 4 Nay 0.

Public Works: Councilman Anderson reported that Duke Energy is doing major work on the gas lines behind Center St. The work will continue until July. The City's contractor is working on Center St. curbs and street. Public Works Dept. is planting trees for the Tree Grant. Public Works Foreman Bowman said that Duke Energy and NKY Water are moving the shut off valves in the street on Center St. while the road is under construction. KY Transportation met with the City and looked at the water drainage problem by the Car Wash. KY DOT will be doing repairs along with the repaving of US 27 from Evergreen to Carothers Rd. It was also discussed that the maintenance of crosswalks on US 27 are the responsibility of the City. Public Works Foreman Bowman will get obtain a to restripe the lines after the state repaves the road.

Public Safety: Councilman Speier distributed the SWEMS report before the meeting. Police Sergeant Johns had no report. Mayor Hamberg asked that the Police Dept. increase patrol at the intersections of Bluegrass and Electric, Walnut and Electric, and Ft. Beech and Winterview.

Code Enforcement: no report.

Community Relations & Recreation: Council Member Payne reported on several upcoming events: Arbor Day 4/20, Fire Dept. Meet and Greet 4/20, and Campbell County Shred Day 4/28.

Public Buildings: no report.

Finance and Administration: Council Member Hayley reviewed the payables. City Clerk Barton said that the newsletter articles are needed by 4/27. Assistant City Attorney Rhoades read a report from City Attorney Stewart about short-term rentals in the City.
