

**CITY OF SOUTHGATE  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
Oct. 3, 2018  
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

**Call to Order:** Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**The following answered roll call:** Council Members Anderson, Hayley, Payne, and Enzweiler, Speier and Robisch present. Also present: City Clerk Barton, Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, Public Works Foreman Bowman, Police Sergeant Johns, and City Attorney Stewart. Fire Chief Beatsch was absent.

**Public Comments:** Mayor Hamberg offered condolence to the family of Rose Welscher who recently passed away. She was the City Clerk in Southgate for over 28 years. Nora Williams, Co-Chairperson of Park & Tree Board read the Green Thumb winners for the month: 320 Snow Shoe (Jay and Sabine Blanchet) and 240 Linden (Joanna Williamson Dawn).

**Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes of 09/19/18. Motion/Second: Speier/Hayley. Approved by voice vote: Aye 6 Nay 0.**

**Public Works:** Councilman Anderson reported that the road construction for intersection of Maple and Center St. is complete. Part of Ft. Beech Dr. has cracks along with a depression in the road. **There was a motion to accept the bid of \$4,500 to do a study with boring samples from Geo Technologies. Motion/Second: Anderson/Robisch. Approved by voice vote: Aye 6 Nay 0.** Public Works Foreman Bowman had no report.

**Public Safety:** Councilman Speier reported that the next SWEMS meeting is Oct. 9th. Sergeant Johns commented on several complaints of a vehicle parked on the street that had expired license plates. There was discussion to revise the current parking ordinance to address this matter. The Police Department has received calls about solicitors in the city. There was discussion to create a new ordinance regarding solicitors.

**Code Enforcement:** Councilman Enzweiler reported 32 active cases and 27 resolved cases. John Lauber, Code Enforcement received Achievement in City Governance award from KLC for completing 29 hours of training.

**Community Relations & Recreation:** Council Member Payne reported on several upcoming events: Movie Night 10/5, Fire Dept. Octoberfest 10/6, Cruise In 10/14, Fire Dept. Stagette 10/19, Campbell County Clean Up 10/19-10/20, and Hazardous Waste event 11/3. Trick or Treat hours 10/31 are 5:30-7:30.

**Public Buildings:** Councilman Robisch said he will check the status of the fire dept door alert repair.

**Finance and Administration:** Council Member Hayley reviewed the payables. **There was a motion to approve the August financials. Motion/Second: Hayley/Speier. Approved by voice vote: Aye 6 Nay 0.**

Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson said the auditors will be onsite Oct. 17. The tax bills are within 1% of budget. The City didn't have to make a draw on the TAN loan this fiscal year. City Clerk

Barton had no report. City Attorney Stewart recommended that the City's Animal Control Committee meet to review the animal ordinance and make revisions.

**Old Business:** none.


