COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
October 17, 2018
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

Call to Order: Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

The following answered roll call: Council Members Anderson, Hayley, Payne, Speier, and Robisch present. Councilman Enzweiler was absent. Also present: City Clerk Barton, Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, Police Chief Christmann, Public Works Foreman Bowman, Fire Chief Beatsch, and City Attorney Stewart.

Public Works: Councilman Anderson had no report. Public Works Foreman Bowman had no report. There was discussion about parking on Retreat St. and on Ridgeway. There are currently 2 handicap parking spots on Retreat. A new request has been submitted for a third space.

Public Safety: Councilman Speier had no report. Police Chief Christmann said two new cruisers were ordered. Motorola is offering special financing for the new digital radios. Fire Chief Beatsch reported on the Oktoberfest held on Oct. 6. The Fire Department is re-applying for a grant to help with the cost of new digital radios.

Code Enforcement: no report.

Community Relations & Recreation: Council Member Payne reported several upcoming events: SVFD Stagetette 10/19, Optimist Club Night at the Races 11/3 at St. Therese, and Northern KY Hazardous Waste event 11/3.

Public Buildings: Councilman Robisch reported that Public Works Foreman Bowman will install the waterproof box to house the second doorbell at the firehouse. Councilman Robisch said he would seek grant money to help build a second shelter and playground for the handicapped which will be located closer to the parking lot.

Finance and Administration: Council Member Hayley reviewed the payables. **There was a motion to cancel the Nov. 21st and Dec. 19th council meetings. Motion/Second: Hayley/Robisch. Approved by voice vote. Aye 5 Nay 0.**

Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson said the auditors are currently onsite conducting fieldwork. City Clerk Barton said that newsletter articles are needed by next week. KLC loss control consultant will be here to inspect City locations and review policy the last week of October. City Attorney Stewart said that she is working on several ordinances that are under review.

Old Business: Council Member Payne said the car show was rained out Sunday Oct. 14th.


New Business: none.
