Public Works: Councilman Anderson reported that a street pre-construction meeting was held this week. North St. will be repaved this year. Other streets will be completed in the spring. Public Works Dept. will start watering and cutting grass in the medians on US 27. Public Works Foreman Bowman had no report.

Public Safety: Council Member Speier had no report. Police Chief Christmann said a sign was installed at the community center parking lot to designate the area as a "safe meet up place" for Offer Up and other sales venues. This location can be used for anyone to meet another party to sell or buy items.
