
IF YOU DO NOT CONTEST THIS CITATION, you must pay the amount shown above as "Total Fine" at the Office of the City Clerk, 122 Electric Avenue, Southgate, KY 41071, within seven (7) calendar days from the date the Citation was issued.

IF YOU DO CONTEST THIS CITATION, you must request a hearing before the City of Southgate Code Enforcement Board within seven (7) calendar days from the date the Citation was issued. Appeal forms are available from and may be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk, 122 Electric Avenue, Southgate, KY 41071. If the Board determines that no violation was committed, an order dismissing the Citation shall be entered. If the Board determines that a violation has been committed, an order may be issued upholding the Citation, and the Board may impose a fine up to \$50.00 per day per violation, up to a maximum of \$10,000.00 per Citation, or require you to remedy a continuing violation to avoid a fine, or both.

IF YOU FAIL TO PAY THE CIVIL FINE SET FORTH IN THIS CITATION OR CONTEST THE CITATION WITHIN THE TIME ALLOWED, you shall be deemed to have waived the right to a hearing before the Code Enforcement Board to contest the citation; the determination that the violation was committed shall be final; the citation as issued shall be deemed a Final Order determining that the violation was committed and imposing the civil fine as set forth in this Citation; and you shall be deemed to have waived the right to appeal the final order to Campbell District Court.

PETER J II LAHNI:

On 12/12/2018 the City of Southgate issued you a Notice of Violation. On 12/21/2018, 1/4/2019, 1/23/2019, 2/8/2019 and again on 2/27/2019 the City issued you citations. These notices required you to correct any and all noted violations within a specified time period. A re-inspection of your property was conducted on 3/21/2019. The following violations were not corrected as required or have occurred again and/or are new (see attached code sections and photographs for details):

- *Outside Storage – remove all storage items from driveway and/or yard. Containers – discontinue storing garbage or recyclable containers in the driveway / front yard. Containers that are stored outside must be kept in rear or side yard.*
- *Containers – discontinue storing garbage or recyclable containers in the driveway / front yard. Containers that are stored outside must be kept in rear or side yard.*

Therefore, the City has issued a Citation for the violations that were not corrected. Attached for your review is the Citation. **Please submit payment for the amount listed under Total Fine. The fine must be paid within seven (7) calendar days of the date of the Citation. If you fail to respond, you shall be deemed to have waived the right to a hearing before the Code Enforcement Board to contest the citation; the determination that the violation was committed shall be final; the citation as issued shall be deemed a final order determining that the violation was committed and imposing the civil fine as set forth in this Citation; and you shall be deemed to have waived the right to appeal the final order to Campbell District Court. 
Please remember that you are still required to correct any and all outstanding violations. The City shall conduct a re-inspection of your property on 4/2/2019. If any violations remain, additional Citations may be issued. The City may also pursue enforcement and resolution through appropriate legal action. *Any action taken by the City of Southgate to abate the violations shall be charged against the real estate upon which the structure is located and a lien shall be placed upon such real estate.*

If you wish to appeal this Citation, you may submit an application for appeal within seven (7) calendar days from the date of this notice. Applications may be picked up and submitted to the City Clerk's office at 122 Electric Avenue, Southgate, KY, 41071.

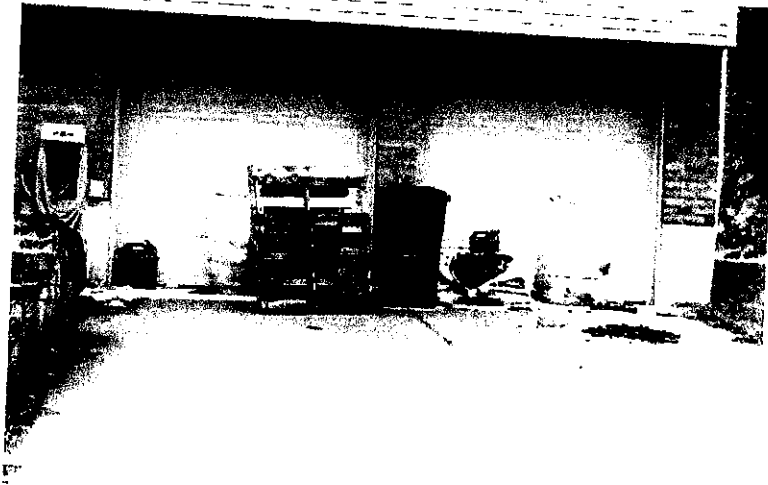

302.1 Sanitation. All exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition and all outdoor storage shall be removed. The occupant shall keep that part of the exterior property which such occupant occupies or controls in a clean and sanitary condition.

City Ordinance Section 30.01, Watertight Containers. All refuse and garbage must be placed in watertight containers with close-fitting lids or covers. Containers must not be set out prior to dusk on the day preceding collection and must be removed as soon as possible within the same day as collection. Waste and recyclable containers shall be stored in the rear yard. However, containers may be stored in the side yard behind the front line of the house. In no case shall containers be stored in the front yard.
