



Call for Park and Tree Board Members
City of Southgate, KY

The City of Southgate, KY, Park and Tree Board is looking for excellent persons who would like to serve on the Board. Board members must be citizens and residents of Southgate and are appointed by the Mayor with approval of the City Council. The Board must consist of at least five but no more than ten members who serve on a volunteer basis without compensation.

The term of office is staggered three year terms, and meetings are held monthly. It is the responsibility of the Board to study, investigate, counsel, develop, and/or update annually a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, replanting, removal, or disposition of trees within the City.

Persons wishing to serve must love the urban forest, be willing to look for funding to assist with parks, recreation, and education initiatives selected by the Board. Persons should be interested in providing educational programs to the community-at-large as needed and work cooperatively with the other Board members, the Mayor, City Council, and City Maintenance staff.
