ORDINANCE NO. 23-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTHGATE, KENTUCKY, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, AMENDING SOLID WASTE FEES FOR WASTE, GARBAGE, TRASH, AND RECYCLING COLLECTION FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL UNITS IN THE CITY OF SOUTHGATE, FOR THE WASTE CONTRACT YEAR 2023 AND 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SOUTHGATE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Pursuant to Sections 50.02 of the City Code of Ordinances for the City of Southgate, Kentucky, the annual waste and recycling collections charges for the waste contract year are set as follows: for all residential dwelling units, the sum of \$282.00 for each unit per annum, including single family homes, multi-family homes, and residential units except those in condominium buildings.

SECTION II

The term dwelling unit is defined in Section 50.01 of the City Code of Ordinances.

SECTION III

The annual solid waste fee shall be added to the property tax bill for each residential property in the City receiving solid waste and recyclable collection services. It shall be due and payable pursuant to Southgate Code of Ordinances § 50.08. Collection service for new dwelling units will be pro-rated according to the move in date. Residents may be billed separately from the tax bill.

SECTION IV

The City of Southgate shall have a lien on all property for which benefit the waste collection charge is hereby levied for payment, and for all penalties, interest, fees, commissions, charges and other expenses including court costs, and attorneys' fees incurred by reason of any delinquency in payment of such charge, or in the process of collecting them and such lien has priority over all other obligations or liabilities for which the property is liable.

SECTION V

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION VI


The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION VII


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
